## Student Records & FERPA-Inspired Policy

At Grace & Growth, we are committed to maintaining comprehensive student records that support each child's academic growth, health, safety, and overall well-being, while respecting the privacy of students and their families. Our approach follows FERPA-inspired guidelines and Idaho law (Idaho Code §18-4511), ensuring that all records are handled responsibly and confidentially.

Each student enrolled at Grace & Growth has a file that includes essential enrollment information, such as parent and guardian contact details, proof of identity and birthdate, and emergency contacts. Academic progress, assessments, and teacher observations are carefully recorded to support each child's learning journey. Additionally, we document health information, including allergies, medications, and any physical restrictions, as well as behavioral observations. In rare cases where a record must be flagged – such as in response to a missing or runaway notification – this is done in strict compliance with legal requirements to ensure the child's safety.

Student records are confidential and accessed only by authorized staff. Parents and guardians have the right to review their child's records at any time. Records are never shared publicly or with third parties without written parental consent, except in circumstances required by law. If a student's record is flagged, such as in the case of a missing or runaway child, the record will not be released without first notifying local law enforcement.

When a student transfers to Grace & Growth from another school, we request the student's records from the previous school within fourteen days of enrollment. Likewise, when records are requested for a student transferring to another school, we comply within ten days, unless a record has been flagged for safety concerns. Any flagged records are handled in accordance with Idaho law, ensuring that law enforcement is notified before any information is released.

Grace & Growth maintains student records securely throughout enrollment and retains them for at least five to seven years after a student leaves the school, following best practices for record retention. After the retention period, records are securely destroyed to maintain confidentiality.

Parents and guardians play an essential role in supporting the integrity of student records. They are responsible for providing accurate enrollment and identification documentation and for keeping the school informed of any changes in contact information, health status, or custody arrangements. Parents should also understand that all Grace & Growth staff are mandated reporters and are legally obligated to report any suspicion of child abuse or neglect to the appropriate authorities.

By enrolling a student at Grace & Growth, parents and guardians acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agree to the policies regarding student records, privacy, and FERPA-inspired protections.
